



Synertec Awarded Contract for Jemena's Northern Gas Pipeline Project

Synertec has been awarded the contract to design, supply and commission the **process control & safety system** for Jemena's \$800million Northern Gas Pipeline (NGP). The contract is set to commence immediately (Q4 2016) with completion due in mid-2018.

The NGP will span between Tennant Creek in the Northern Territory and Mount Isa in Queensland. The aim of this 622km pipeline is to connect gas fields in the Northern Territory to Australia's east coast gas market.
